

MOSI Traveling Exhibit EGYPT: Puzzles & Mysteries

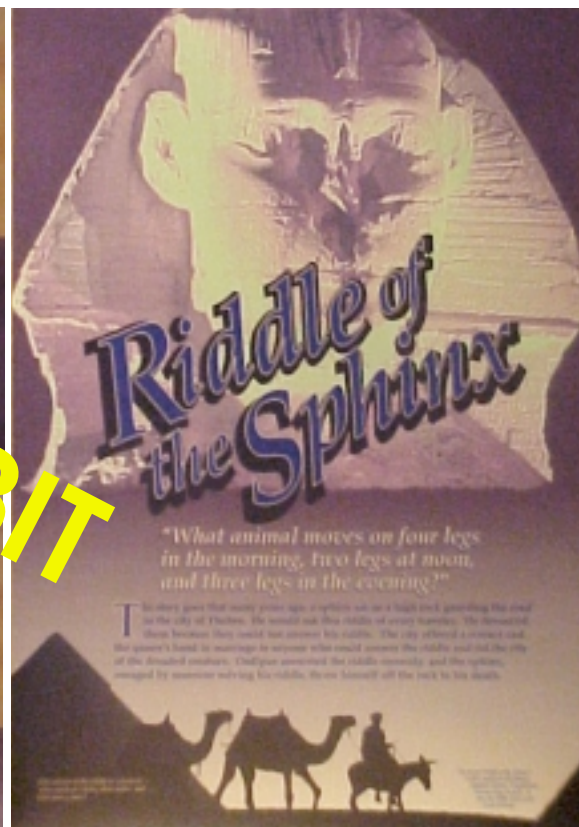


Exhibit Description

Egypt: Puzzles and Mysteries is an engaging, thought-provoking exhibit which explores the geography, history, technology and mystery of ancient Egypt in a fun and playful way. Through hands-on interactions and program demonstrations, kids of all ages discover what it might have been like to live, work and play in Egypt during the time of the pyramids.

Older kids and adults too can use their brains to figure out the riddles and try to solve all the puzzles. All of the riddles and puzzles have an Egyptian slant, and at least one puzzle has never been solved.

Visitors to the exhibit can leave with a souvenir, a photograph of themselves and their friends as Egyptian characters.

What Visitors Do

- Explore the geography of Egypt
- Ponder six ancient riddles
- Try to solve five perplexing puzzles
- Build pyramids from wood blocks
- Learn about the math, history and construction methods of pyramids.
- See and be photographed as a mummy, King Tut, Anubis and Cleopatra in Egyptian photo-op.
- Write like an Egyptian using hieroglyphics
- Walk like an Egyptian, along walls and through a maze painted to resemble the insides of a pyramid.

Exciting Demonstrations

- Play Egyptian board games
- Operate simple machines that might have helped build the pyramids
- Make a mummy
