

MOS"e" Learning Hub FAQs

MOSI has increased health and safety measures in order to combat the effects of COVID-19. These safety measures which follow the CDC guidelines have been in place since June 1st and we have had a successful summer camp.

What precautions is MOSI taking due to COVID-19?

- MOSI utilizes cleaning products and protocols which meet CDC guidelines and are approved for use and effective against viruses and bacteria
- The frequency of cleaning and sanitizing has been increased
- Staff and students will have a daily temperature check upon entering
- Classes will have a cap on the number of students permitted in order for social distancing to occur
- Parents and visitors will NOT be allowed in the classrooms
- All food must be brought from home and no sharing will be allowed
- Lunch will be outside at picnic tables in the covered area
- Lunch groups and outside play time will be staggered
- Frequent hand washing will be incorporated into the daily routine of each student
- Signage will be posted reminding employees, parents and students of distancing guidelines.
- Multiple hand sanitizer dispensers have been placed throughout the MOSI Center for Learning
- Our management team will maintain ongoing communication with employees and ensure proper PPE and sanitation procedures are being followed
- Students will use the same computer and headset the entire week and they will not be shared

What does my child need to bring?

- Log-in information for the e-learning platform for your school
- Lunch and two snacks
- The first day of e-learning the parent needs to send in the Pick-Up Authorization Form and the Program Information Form

What time can I drop my child off?

- Drop off will begin at 7:15am. Elementary e-learning classes begin at 7:40am. Middle School e-learning classes begin at 9:15; however they can be dropped off at 7:15.

What time do I pick my child up?

- Your child must be picked up at 4:00pm or earlier.
- A photo ID is required for pick up.

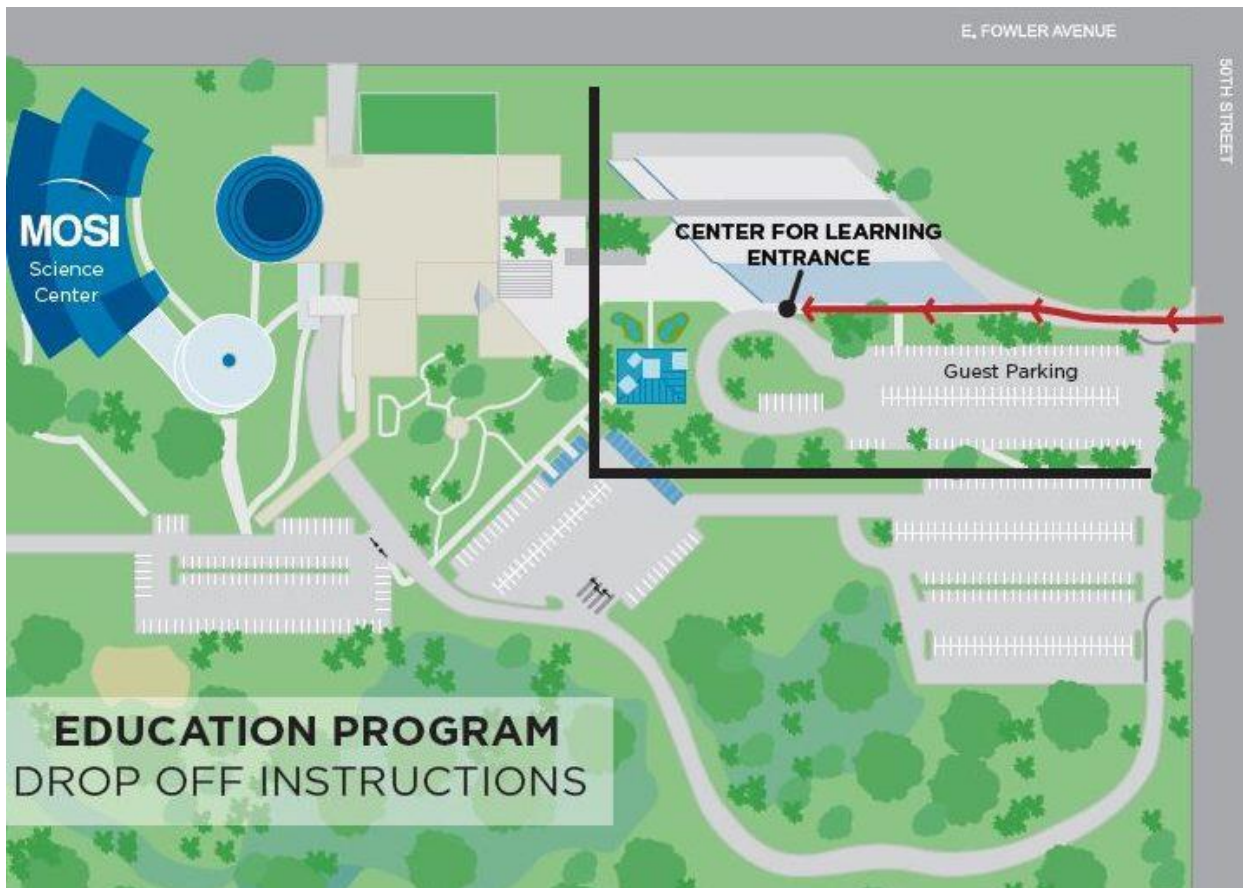
Where do I drop off and pick-up my child?
