



2021 Spring Break and Summer Camp FAQ regarding COVID-19

The safety and health of campers and staff is always the highest priority at MOSI. Due to COVID-19 we have reviewed and updated our health-related procedures. During the summer of 2020 we operated twelve weeks of summer camp safely for our staff and campers.

Will summer camps occur this summer?

We plan to hold spring break camp March 15 – 19 and ten weeks of summer camps beginning June 1 – August 6th. We are currently accepting registrations. Camps will have capacity limits on them, so be sure to register as soon as possible as they will fill up quickly!

What if MOSI has to cancel camps due to COVID-19.

If you are registered for camp and MOSI has to cancel them, you will receive a full refund or can transfer to a later week of camp (if camps are postponed).

What precautions is MOSI Spring and Summer Camp take due to COVID-19?

MOSI will be following the CDC guidelines for keeping our campers and spaces safe.

- Camps will have a capacity limits on the number of campers in each camp.
- Campers will be expected to wear a face mask per Hillsborough County Ordinance.
- Only campers and camp personnel will be allowed in the camp classrooms.
- Any staff member or camper who is ill or has a fever will be immediately sent home.
- Staff members will have their temperature taken upon arrival.
- Disinfecting of classrooms and items in classrooms will occur multiple times throughout the day.
- Campers will be encouraged to wash hands multiple times throughout the day and hand sanitizer will always be available.
- Campers will bring their own food.
- Campers will be spread out as much as possible to maintain distancing.
